PREPARING FOR WINTER STORMS

Being prepared before a winter storm is important for you and your family's safety and comfort. If a winter storm is predicted it is a good idea to make sure you have adequate supply of propane in your tank. If your tank is low, contact us right away so we can schedule a delivery. When the storm is over, make sure you clear a path to the tank to be prepared for your next delivery. Clear heavy snow and ice from regulators, regulator vents, piping, tubing and valves. Appliance vents, chimneys and flues must be kept clear of snow so appliances can vent properly. If you see any damage or blockages, call us right away!

Propane Inventory & Prices

The last few years have been a roller coaster ride regarding propane prices. We know everyone is wondering what is going on and what happened to traditional trends? In 2007 US propane exports were 6 million barrels and imports of 18 million barrels were needed to meet US demands. This year the US expects to see 47 million barrels of exports and 4 million barrels of imports. In 5 years the US has gone from import dependent to a major exporter. This continues to affect our pricing in the US. We monitor prices on a daily basis and do our best to alert you when there are opportunities to lock into lower contract propane. Keeping an eye on these trends and watching for patterns that will help us be better buyers will continue to be an ongoing focus for us.

Remember if you are a **Will Call** customer (you call us when you need propane) allow 3 working days for delivery.
